

Majors and Career FAQs

Q. I would like to change my **major** . How do I change or add a major?

A. You do *not* need to meet with your current advisor to declare or change your major. To declare a major, you will usually have to attend a major meeting. At the meeting, a departmental representative will go over basic information about the major and review requirements. At the end of the meeting, you will have an opportunity fill out the paperwork to declare. Q. What is **IUT**ing? OR I want to change my major to Business, Engineering, Architecture, Journalism or Music?

A. Intra-university transfer is when you want to go from Arts and Science to another college within the university. These include Business, Architecture, Engineering, Journalism and Music. You can not simply declare these degrees but must apply. Keep your eye out for IUT meetings during the semester that will give you info on how to apply and when. Many have pre-requisite classes so ask your advisor about what you should be taking in order to apply.

Q. What if I have questions about **careers or internships**?

A. Career counseling is available for all students on campus. They can help by doing interest and skills testing or just giving you more info about the careers you are interested in pursuing.
