### New Financial Reports Available

Beginning in October, the new COGNOS financial reporting tool will be available for use for anyone assigned a Speedtype fiscal role. Starting the second week of October, reports will be “burst” to the CUConnect portal. Any faculty or staff assigned a Speedtype fiscal role will be sent an email alerting them that their reports are ready to view via CUConnect.

To access CUConnect, visit the link provided in the reporting email or click on the link below. In order to sign in, you will need your CU Identikey user name and password. For help with Identikey passwords, please call the ITS helpline at (303) 735-HELP. Once you are logged on to CUConnect, click on the *myReport* tab. Here you can access all the reports that you are required to review.

You will only receive reports for Speedtypes for which you have a fiscal role. Please review your reports monthly and verify that all information is correct. All abnormal balances will be in parentheses, with red text, and/or highlighted in pink. If you notice an abnormal balance, please contact your department fiscal staff.

If you do not get reports that you know you should, or the contact information on your reports is inaccurate, please send an email to [accounting@colorado.edu](mailto:accounting@colorado.edu). Accounting and Business Support will attempt to have the error corrected by the next monthly report.
