**Directions from Hotels to Conference Venues**

**The fundamental principle of directions in Boulder is:**

THE MOUNTAINS ARE ALWAYS TO THE WEST

**The fundamental principle of conference venues is:**

NORLIN LIBRARY BRITISH STUDIES ROOM is the site for all events on THURSDAY MARCH 22 AND FRIDAY MARCH 23; events in Norlin will be held on the fourth floor in the British Studies Room; take the west entrance (above which Cicero is quoted, in English) and follow the signs to the British Studies Room

THE EATON HUMANITIES BUILDING is the site for all events on SATURDAY MARCH 24 AND SUNDAY MARCH 25

Directions from the Quality Inn: Leaving the hotel, turn left and head west on Arapahoe > turn left and head south on 19<sup>th</sup> > continue past student housing until you reach the Boulder Creek Path (a pump station is on your left) > turn right and head west on the creek path until you see a bridge over the creek with a sign marked “17<sup>th</sup> Street” > bear right at the fork and up the path onto 17<sup>th</sup> St. > turn **left on 17<sup>th</sup> St.** and walk up a steep hill, bearing left at the fork and up the flagstone steps > at the top of the hill, follow the curve of the road south until it dead-ends into the Eaton Humanities Building; Norlin Library is just south-east of Eaton Humanities.

NB You can also simply head west on Arapahoe to 17<sup>th</sup>, turn left and head south on 17<sup>th</sup>, and continue with the directions in the paragraph above (but you’ll miss the [brief] walk along Boulder Creek).

Directions from the Hotel Boulderado and the Boulder University Inn: Both of these hotels are on Broadway. The Boulder University Inn is the closer of the two to the University campus. The walk from the Boulderado will take at least 30 minutes; that from the Boulder University Inn will take 10 minutes. To walk from either hotel, leaving the hotel turn left and head south on Broadway > continue up a steep hill (past Arapahoe, for Boulderado guests) at the top of which you encounter University Avenue > cross to the **south-east corner of University and Broadway** and continue on the paved path that cuts southeast through the campus > you will cross a large pond on a bridge beyond which you will meet a limited access road (Pleasant St.) > turn left on the road and continue due east until you see the Eaton Humanities Building; Norlin Library is just south-east of Eaton Humanities.

Those at the Hotel Boulderado may wish to use the RTD bus service. Exiting the hotel, go west to Broadway and stand at the bus stop sign on the west (far) side of Broadway. Take any bus marked “SKIP”, a jitney service scheduled every 10 minutes (20 after 6:00 pm). The bus fare is \$1.25 and the driver will accept cash but will not give change. Continue south until you reach the stop just past University Ave. Exit the bus and cross Broadway to the south-east corner of University and Broadway, then pick up the directions in the paragraph above.
