The CU-LEAD Scholarship Fund is aimed at recruiting and retaining a diverse student body. The scholarship program offers a range of services and financial benefits for highly motivated individuals. Students enrolled in the ELLC Leadership Studies Program are eligible to apply for a \$6,000 CU LEAD Alliance Scholarship. Scholarship recipients will receive \$1,500 each year for four years contingent on full-time enrollment, reasonable academic progress and continued participation in the ELLC program. In addition, students who receive the LEAD Alliance Scholarship will receive a one-time award of \$725 to cover the cost to the residential academic program participation fee.
