

## **Executive Committee Meeting**

**Monday, March 28, 2005**

Elizabeth Dunn has agreed to write an alcohol report for the BFA with ideas as to how the campus should address the problem long-term; Bintliff encouraged everyone to read and comment on the draft report when it becomes available.

The Chancellor's report on Ward Churchill was released last week and the Chair asked the committee for their thoughts and comments.

Faculty Council has initiated a review of the tenure process as there is a lack of public confidence and understanding of the university's procedures regarding tenure and there are numerous legislators as well as the governor who have spoken about eliminating tenure
