

Dear Colorado Gateway participants,

Our Gateway orientation is now just over one week away!

I've put some helpful information into this email for your trip to Boulder and for settling in here.

Arrival:

- **Transportation options from airport:** You can find information about how to get to Boulder from the airport here: <http://www.colorado.edu/OIE/issss/travel.html>
- **Housing:** You will be staying in Sewall Hall, a residence hall on the University of Colorado at Boulder campus.
- **Most direct route:** If you choose the Super Shuttle, they can take you right to the residence hall. Just ask to be let off at Sewall Hall. The address there is: 1720 University Avenue, Boulder.
- **Bus option:** If you choose the RTD SkyRide bus, ask to be let off at Euclid and Broadway in Boulder (near the University Memorial Center - UMC). Then walk through campus to Sewall Hall or, if you arrive between 9 am and 4:30 pm, you may stop first at the Office of International Education (OIE). We will have some carts to help you get your luggage to Sewall Hall.
- **Check-in available 24/hours/day:** It is no problem if you arrive late.

Monday evening:

Check-in: When you check in at **Sewall Hall** you will receive your room key, wireless internet access including a login and password, a campus map, and a short note from us. Please note that:

1. You will be sharing a room with another Fulbrighter.
 2. Smoking is not permitted in housing facilities.
 3. All individuals who are under the legal drinking age of 21 may not consume or possess alcohol. Individuals who are of legal drinking age may possess and consume alcohol only in the privacy of their room with the door closed. Alcohol cannot be consumed or carried in open containers on any street, sidewalk, alley, automobile, or public area on campus.
- **Phones:** Unfortunately there are no pay phones in the residence hall. The closest pay phones are located inside the University Memorial Center (UMC). The phones are located behind the stairs on the first floor of the UMC. The UMC hours are 7am - 10pm.
 - **Computer access:** If you've brought your own computer with a wireless card, you can use the university's wireless system. If you don't have your own computer, you can use the "Scarpie" computers around campus. For access on Monday night, your best choices would be at:
 1. **Norlin Library:** Hours are 7:30 am - 9:00pm. From Sewall walk west toward the main part of campus, through the parking lot, and across University Ave. at the cross walk. Follow the footpath into the Norlin Quad (grassy area) and then walk left, up the Norlin

library steps. When you enter, turn right and head into the Science Library. None of these computers require a student log-in ID. There are also a dozen Scarpie computers located throughout the library.

2. University Memorial Center (UMC): Hours are 7am - 10pm. Two Scarpie computers are located below the stairwell on the main floor of the UMC. Enter the UMC from the UMC Dalton Trumbo Fountain Court entrance (east side) and walk directly back, past the stairs and just past the ATM.

- **Dinner:** Dinner is available in the dining room of Sewall Hall from 5:00-6:30pm. It is cafeteria-style and you can eat any time you'd like during these hours.
- **No program on Monday:** The first program activities start on Tuesday morning.

Tuesday morning:

- **Breakfast:** A cafeteria-style breakfast will be available in the Sewall Hall dining room from 7:00-8:30 (but you should be finished eating by 8:15 in order to get to the University Memorial Center (UMC) in time for the first session.
- **First event:** Registration is at the University Memorial Center (UMC) Ballroom from 8:15-8:45am. **Please arrive at the UMC by 8:30am.** It takes about 5-10 minutes to walk to the UMC from Sewall Hall. Our first session will begin promptly at 8:45 at the end of the registration period.
