UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO PRE-COLLEGIATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2012-13

Purpose

The primary goals of the Pre-Collegiate Scholarship Program of the University of Colorado are to encourage eligible graduates of the Pre-Collegiate Program to attend the University, and to enhance diversity at the University by encouraging and providing opportunity to well-qualified students of historically underrepresented groups at the University. In this effort, the Pre-Collegiate Scholarship Program awards scholarships to individuals to help cover the costs of education, which may include tuition, books, and fees. Initial funding for this scholarship has been provided by The Pioneer Fund on behalf of Helen M. McLoraine.

Eligibility

To apply for a scholarship, applicants must be graduates of the Pre-Collegiate Program, and be enrolled or admitted for full-time study at the University of Colorado. Students must be academically well-qualified (minimum 2.75 grade point average on a 4.0 scale) and be in the first generation of persons in their family to graduate from college. Additionally, students must demonstrate financial need.

Award

Scholarships must be used toward the recipient's educational expenses. Awards vary in amount and are divided equally between the fall and spring semesters. Scholarships are automatically renewed each academic year up to 5 years given satisfactory academic performance and full-time enrollment.

All Application Packets Must Include:

- Completed scholarship application form (attached)
- **Required:** one nomination form (attached) completed by a Pre-Collegiate Program director or staff member.
- **Optional:** one nomination form (attached) completed by a Pre-Collegiate Program Peer Advocate.
- An essay of one page or less (see essay question on application form). **Be sure it includes your name and CU student ID.**
- Submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required by April 1, 2012. This can be done electronically at <http://www.fafsa.edu.gov>.
- Additional attachment, such as a résumé, are optional.
