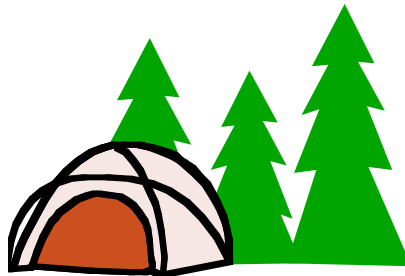
**HOMEWARD BOUND**
