9:30 GOOD NIGHT!

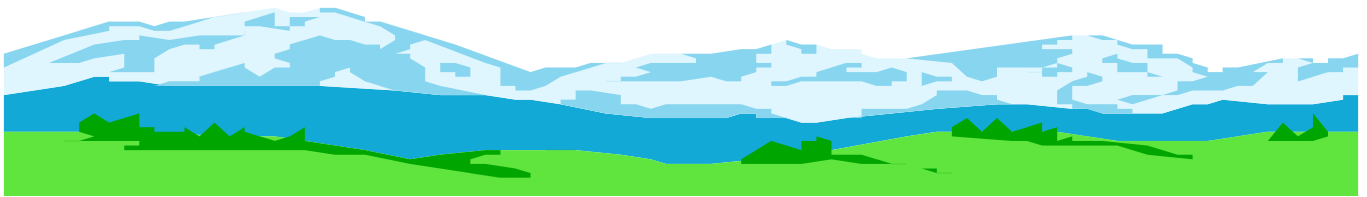
