Complete this form to increase your Cost of Attendance budget. By increasing your budget, you **may become eligible for additional loan money** in the form of Parent Loans, Stafford Loans and/or alternative loans. NOTE: This process will not make you eligible for (more) grant funds.

To increase your budget for a computer purchase, you **must purchase the computer during your period of summer enrollment or within a reasonable period of time prior to becoming enrolled.**

IMPORTANT: Complete this form and **submit with documentation of the cost** for computer, hardware, or software you have purchased (receipts) OR plan to purchase (estimates from the vendor).

An initial computer purchase, including CPU, monitor, printer and basic software, can be obtained at a base price of approximately \$1000. Additional upgrades of hardware and software that may be needed during the college career should not exceed \$1500. Given this information, the Office of Financial Aid will allow students to increase their cost of attendance by a total of \$2500 for any 3-year period.

Additional Information:

- The adjustment does not have to be done at one time. You can purchase equipment as you need it.
- The adjustment may or may not result in a change in the amount of financial aid you receive.
- Any increase in aid will be in the form of loans. For PLUS loans, parents must pass a credit check.
- Additional funds offered will be available beginning 3 days before your summer classes begin.

- CPU: Desktop - iMac 1.83 GHz Intel or Intel Core Duo/Pentium 4/Celeron 3.0 GHz; Laptop - iBook with Intel processor or Intel Core Solo & Duo/Pentium M/Celeron 1.8 GHz
- RAM: 1 GB
- Hard Drive: Desktop - 160 GB for desktop; Laptop - 100 GB, 7200 RPM
- Video Adapter: Desktop - Graphics Card with 64 MB or greater; Laptop - Graphics Card with 32 MB or greater
- Network Access: 10/100 Network Card and/or Modem; (For Residence Halls, Housing recommends these network cards or latest revisions of these models: for desktop, D-Link DFE-530TX or 3Com 3C905C-TX; for laptop, D-Link DFE-650TX or 3Com 3CCFE574BT)
