High-ranking submissions receive cash awards, with the first place winners securing an invitation to participate in the prestigious AIAA National Student Conference.

An undergraduate Team category is also included in the conference, for work involving more than two authors. These efforts are reviewed as well, with cash prizes for top finishers.
