1. PURPOSE

To describe the circumstances under which Designated Member Review (DMR) may be used for review of applications.

2. DEFINITIONS

Designated Member Review (DMR): a procedure in which named members of the IACUC are assigned responsibility for reviewing information provided in response to a Full Committee Review of an application

3. PROCEDURES

- A quorum of members present at a convened IACUC meeting may decide by unanimous vote of those present to use a designated member review subsequent to the IACUC meeting (i.e. after the full committee review is completed) when modification is needed to secure approval.
- Any member of the IACUC may, at any time, request to see the revised protocol and/or request full committee review of the protocol.
