The 2006 Accepted/Applied Chart below contains University of Colorado at Boulder-specific data. This chart may be used to estimate your chances of admission to allopathic (M.D.) medical schools based only on undergraduate GPA and MCAT scores. The chart does not include data from CU students who did not use the Committee Letter process as they have often not had any contact with the Prehealth Advising Office.

The national accepted/applied information given below the chart can be useful in reviewing the UCB charts and show that UCB students are accepted at rates well above the national average, despite the fact that we do not restrict who applies to medical school.
