FRSI 1010 Beginning Farsi I

M-F 2:00-2:50pm, HUMN 180

Provides a grounding in basic Farsi grammar. The morphological and phonological nuances of the language will be introduced, along with Persian culture. Basic conversation is reinforced on a daily basis with strong emphasis and reiteration upon the homework and covered grammar.

FRSI 2110 Intermediate Farsi I

M-TH 1:00-1:50pm, HUMN 186

Provides an intensive introduction to cultural and literary texts of Iran, along with an introduction of the grammatical and rhetorical complexities of Persian prose and poetry. Students continue to develop speaking, listening, and writing skills through activities based on the readings. Prereq., FRSI 1020 (min. grade C), or instructor consent. Meets MAPS and approved for arts and sciences core curriculum: foreign language.

FRSI 1051 Masterpieces of Persian Literature

MWF 11:00-11:50am, HALE 240

Offers a broad introduction to Persian literature, one of the richest traditions in world literature. Students will read a selection of poetry by Rumi, Hafiz, Omar Khayyam, as well as a variety of works written by leading Iranian contemporary poets and writers. Through a close reading of literary texts, this course emphasizes their historical and cultural context. Taught in English.
