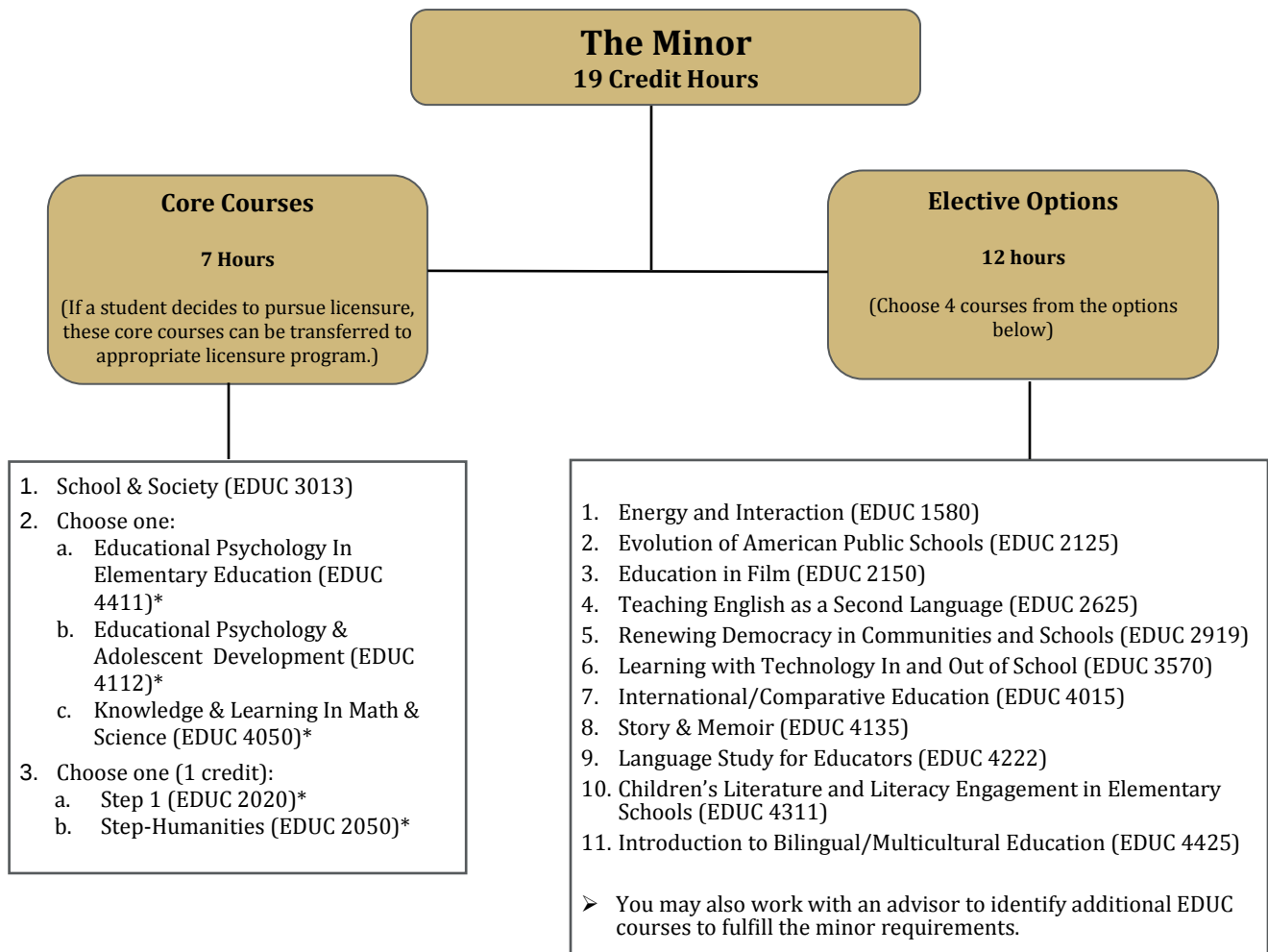




WHY THE ED MINOR?
