

Registration Guide

Secondary (7-12) Teacher Licensure Program

Know your program plan: There are many ways to progress through the teacher licensure program and each student's situation will be unique. Do you plan to finish in 3, 4, or more semesters? Ultimately, it is **the student's** responsibility to plan their path and register for the appropriate courses each term. To prepare for registration, collect your *Admission Letter*, *Requirement Checklist*, and the *Program Completion Plan*.

Fill out the *Program Completion Plan*

1. Carefully review your *Requirement Checklist*, checking for Content Requirements **highlighted in yellow**. A highlighted requirement is a deficiency that you must fulfill *prior* to the student teaching semester. Write any of these requirements and the number of semester hours needed under the Liberal Arts/Content Area Deficiencies section of the course plan.
2. Review your *Admission Letter*. If you have to complete a course for the Basic Skills requirement, be sure to include these courses in your plan.
3. If you have not yet completed EDUC 3013 and Educational Psychology*, you should plan to do so during your first semester in the program. Also estimate when you will fulfill any content deficiencies and how long it will take you to complete the entire program.

*EDUC 4112 for English and Social Studies; EDUC 4050 for Mathematics and Science.

4. Fill in the Completion Plan section of the form using the course information filled in above, your estimate for completing the program, and the course options shown on the back of the page.

A Few Things to Keep in Mind...

1. Some of the courses listed under the Course Options section below include a practicum or field-based experience. Practicum placements are arranged for you by the Director of Field Experiences or by the course instructor. Note that practicum times for these courses include travel time to and from your placement site. For more information about practicum, please refer to the [Advising Handbook](#).
2. We encourage you take at least one course toward an academic deficiency in your first semester. Know that you may need to be flexible in selecting courses and times for deficiencies. If you are unsure about what would be an appropriate course to fulfill a deficiency or long it will take you to complete the program, then please contact the Student Advisor in the Office of Student Services. Call (303) 492-6555 to schedule an appointment prior to registration. If you need to meet with the advisor, we recommend doing this sooner than later – appointment times become full quickly during registration periods.

Registration Problems

If you encounter problems registering for education (EDUC) courses, contact Matt Orr in the Office of Student Services at matt.orr@colorado.edu or (303) 492-4306. Be prepared to explain specifics about the problem: the **catalog number** (i.e. EDUC 3013), the **section number** (i.e. 001), information for any **linked courses/practica**, and your **student ID number**.

Minimum Academic Progress

Teacher licensure students must complete a minimum of one (1) education (EDUC) course per semester. Failure to meet this requirement will result in dismissal from the program. Students that cannot meet this expectation should discuss their plan with the education advisor well in advance of the respective term.

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Course Recommendations

The course recommendations below assume a full course load for the candidate who wants to complete the program in three semesters. Anyone who intends to progress through the program at a slower pace may choose an alternative sequence of courses. However, it will take longer than three semesters to complete the program.

All candidates should take EDUC 3013 during their first semester if they have not already done so. Students with academic deficiencies should take at least one deficiency course toward the completion of the content requirements in their first semester (unless stated otherwise in the admission letter).
