Dear Admissions Counselor:

The above non-degree student is currently in violation of the Reasonable Academic Progress (RAP) standard at the University of Colorado at Boulder Financial Aid Office. Due to this violation, the student is not eligible for financial aid at this time and is filing an appeal to be reconsidered for aid. RAP is a federal, state and institutional policy to ensure that students who are receiving financial aid are making satisfactory academic progress toward obtaining their degree. At CU-Boulder, reasonable academic progress for **non-degree** students is measured by:

- (1) Maintaining a semester and cumulative 2.0 GPA, (2) Completing 100% of all courses attempted, and**
- (3) Finishing an undergraduate degree program within 180 attempted credit hours.**

Non-degree students qualify for aid on the basis that they are taking courses necessary to apply for admission within a year or 12 consecutive months. The RAP Committee asks that you evaluate the student's admissions status based on his/her current academic performance. This information is pertinent in determining whether or not it will be appropriate to continue funding the student.
