Dear Boulder Campus Employees,

For over 13 years, Wardenburg Health Center (WHC) has been treating campus employees who have experienced on-the-job injuries. Our healthcare providers have had the pleasure of caring for fellow staff from almost every department within the university. We have always felt that our services should extend to the whole campus community whenever possible. We have a unique blend of medical expertise and we have always been eager to share this on campus.

However, as a responsible business organization, we have re-evaluated our mission as a student health center and our accountability to funding from our past and current students as well as funding expected from future students on this campus. After careful consideration, a difficult decision was made to give up our role as the campus Worker's Compensation treating facility in order to maintain our focus on the health and wellness of our student population.

As a result, effective June 1, 2007, employees who seek medical care due to a new work-related injury or illness will be required to be treated by Arbor Occupational Medicine located at 4790 Table Mesa Drive, Suite 200, South Boulder as specified by University Risk Management (URM). Our existing Worker's Compensation patients should continue to have follow-up appointments at WHC; your treating provider here will need to officially transfer your care (a legal requirement) to Arbor Occupational Medicine. As always, if an injury is life or limb threatening, go immediately to the nearest hospital emergency room.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank faculty and staff for your support and appreciation over the years. It has been a privilege to serve you.
