Thursday, December 3, 2009

Application due from students planning to graduate with Departmental and/or General Honors in Spring 2010. The thesis application must have *all the required signatures* and be submitted to Honors Program Office in Norlin Library, Room M400M.

Thursday, January 28, 2010 from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. in Library N410

Informational meeting (optional) for all Spring 2010 candidates graduating with Departmental and/or General Honors.

Tuesday, April 6, 2010 due by 4:00 p.m.

THE DEFENSE COPY (stapled or clipped - does not have to be bound) of the Senior Thesis for Spring 2010 candidates is due in the Honors Program Office, Norlin M400M **by 4:00 p.m.** Candidates are responsible for distributing the defense copy of their thesis to members of their thesis defense committee. Your committee may require an earlier deadline. **THIS IS THE VERSION OF THE THESIS THAT WILL DETERMINE YOUR LEVEL OF HONORS.**

Wednesday, April 7, 2010

LAST DAY TO DEFEND DEPARTMENTAL and GENERAL HONORS THESIS -You can defend any time prior to this date.

Honors Thesis Defenses: room should be scheduled with the individual departments or with the assistance of your thesis advisor.

Monday, April 12, 2010 due by 12:00 p.m. (NOON)

Recommendation letters from thesis advisors and committee members for Spring 2010 candidates are due in the Honors Program Office located in Norlin Library, Room M400M.

Tuesday, April 13, 2010 due at 12:00 p.m. (NOON)

THE ARCHIVAL COPY (Velo bound) of the Senior Thesis for Spring 2010 candidates are due in the Honors Program Office **by 12:00 Noon**. The thesis must be Velo bound (the UMC Copy Center does this). **No spiral binding.** The cover page of the thesis must include the following: date, student name, department, thesis title, and the committee members and their department. Specify which committee member was the thesis advisor. **THE ARCHIVAL COPY MAY INCORPORATE CHANGES RESULTING FROM THE THESIS DEFENSE BUT THESE CHANGES WILL NOT BEAR ON THE LEVEL OF HONORS ACHIEVED.**
