

HUMAN ANATOMY HOMEWORK DIRECTIONS & HELPFUL HINTS

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

- 1) **Download** the homework from CU Learn under COURSE CONTENT.
Both Word and PDF files are available. (All figures should be visible on the PDF.)
- 2) **Submit** your responses through a CU Learn “quiz” under the ASSESSMENT tool.
- 3) **Important features** of CU Learn Assessment:
 - a. **You CAN save your assessment responses** to change and/or add responses at a later time. Thus you only need to submit ONCE when you are confident of your answer choices. However, you will still be allowed to submit multiple times if you wish.
 - b. **Click the FINISH button to submit your answers.** If you do not click the finish button, you will not submit your homework.
 - c. Some questions on the assessment may be in a different format from the worksheet but will include all the same information. For example, tables will often be matching questions on the assessment.
 - d. Scores and feedback will be available online the day after the homework is due.
- 4) **Answers to other common questions:**
 - a. If you submit multiple times, the highest score is recorded.
 - b. Partial credit is given for questions with multiple parts. (Note: When questions include “Choose all that apply”, point fractions are taken off for incorrect answers as well.)
 - c. If you cannot see the figures on the Word file, try the PDF file.
 - d. Once the homework is graded, you can view the submission (gray box next to the name of the assessment). By clicking on the link to your attempt, you’ll see both your answers, the correct answers, and for many questions feedback if you answered incorrectly.

HINTS for making the homework as beneficial as possible:

- 1) **Work with others.** We highly encourage you to work on the homework together and learn with each other.
- 2) **Use the worksheet to test yourself.** Try to answer what you can without study materials. Then go back through and double-check your work and fill in holes in your knowledge.
- 3) **Use the assessment tool to test yourself.** Try to fill in the assessment without referring to your worksheet. Then double-check your answers with your completed worksheet to make sure you’ve filled the assessment in correctly. The more times you test yourself on this material, the better you will remember it.
- 4) **Ask yourself why it makes sense that the correct answers are correct AND why the wrong answers are wrong.**
- 5) **Review the FEEDBACK after the homework is due.**
