July 17 & 18, departure from Boulder to Garden City, Kansas: learn how immigrant workers contribute to the agricultural sector and the meatpacking industry in the rural US. We will also hear the perspectives of conservative lawmakers.

July 19: travel to Chicago, Illinois to partner with the Mexico Solidarity Network. From July 19-25, learn about grassroots organizing on issues related to fair wages, access to affordable housing, healthcare and immigration reform.

July 26: depart for Detroit, Michigan, we will learn from the Boggs Center to Nurture Community Leadership (July 25-30) about education alternatives in a post-industrial city.

July 30-31: in Omaha, Nebraska, we will learn about Immigration and Customs Enforcement raids on meatpacking plants.
