## Additional AV Tips

Are the sides of your laptop display getting cut off?

Change the screen resolution:

1. Right-click on your desktop screen, then select Properties.
2. Click on the Settings tab.
3. Under Screen resolution, drag the arrow to 1024 x 768, then Apply.
4. Click Yes. To return to original resolution, repeat steps except move arrow up to high end.

### Using the microphone

The microphone may be used with the AV system ON or OFF

Press the button at the base of the microphone to turn it on

- Green light means **ON**
- Even with the system off, the control panel's volume and mute buttons work



### Using two projectors (Available in 204, 205, 206, 207, and 301)

#### 1 Turn on the right projector

- a Press the **RIGHT** button
- b Press the **MENU** button
- c Touch **Projector Controls** on the screen, then **On**

#### 2 Lower the right screen

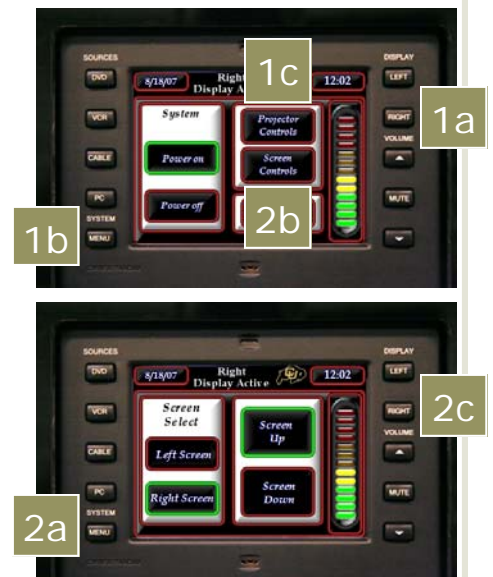
- a Press the **MENU** button
- b Touch **Screen Controls** on the screen
- c With **Right Screen** selected, touch **Screen Down**

#### 3 Send a signal to the right projector

- a Press the **RIGHT** button
- b Press a button to indicate the source (**DVD**, **PC**, etc.)

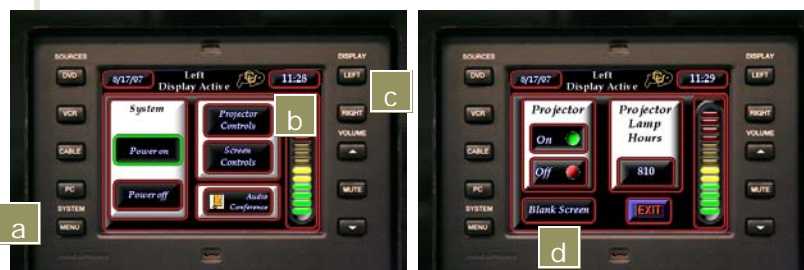
#### Notes

- The last source selected will have the sound
- You may send the same signal to both projectors
- You may also send different signals to each projector, except remember there is only one TV/VCR/DVD, so you may only send one of those signals



### Blanking a screen

Make the projected image go "black" until you're ready



- a Press the **MENU** button
- b Touch screen's **Projector Controls**
- c Press **LEFT** or **RIGHT** projector
- d Touch **Blank Screen**
  - To turn on the projector, touch **Blank Screen** again
