Article 4. Special Provisions for Transfer Students

§3-4-1 Credit for Work Done Elsewhere

- A. Credit for study in foreign law schools by any category of student will be handled as the cases arise by the Dean's Office. In general, credit will be given only for work of acceptable quality done in law schools teaching the common
 - B. law system and with academic standards apparently comparable to Colorado.
