- Evidence (3 credits)
- Property (5 credits).
- Legal Writing (2 credits)
- Appellate Court Advocacy (2 credits)
- Legal Ethics and Professionalism (3 credits)^{4b}

(1) Completion of a course in which participation in actual or simulated applications of practical legal skills are a substantial part of students' work.
