#### Application Checklist and Instructions

1. Signed and dated application. If you attach any extra pages, please make sure that your name and LSAC ID# are at the top of each.
2. Application fee—a nonrefundable \$65 check or money order, made payable to the University of Colorado.
3. Your personal essay. Your essay should be no more than 1000 words, typed and double-spaced.
4. Your résumé or CV.
5. Two letters of recommendation. We prefer that recommendations be submitted through LSAC; however they may be enclosed with your application or sent directly to the Admissions Committee by the writer. A photocopy of the Evaluation of Applicant form must accompany any letters sent directly to the Admissions Committee. At least one of the recommendation letters should be from a professor.
6. All applicants must register for the Law School Data Assembly Service (LSDAS) (see [www.lsac.org](http://www.lsac.org)) and must take the Law School Admission Test (LSAT). LSAT scores are good for five years. The February LSAT is the last one we will accept.  
Transcripts from all colleges and universities previously attended must be submitted through LSDAS. If an applicant matriculates, he or she must provide the University of Colorado with two original transcripts from each college or university attended. The transcripts submitted to LSAC will not satisfy this requirement.
7. Application for In-State Tuition Status in Colorado. You must complete this section of the application to be considered for in-state tuition status.
8. If you have attended any other law school(s), you will need to submit an official transcript and a letter of good standing from the dean of the law school(s) directly to the University of Colorado Law School Office of Admissions.
