## Entrepreneurial Law Certificate Enrollment Application and Tracking Form

A participating student must earn 95 semester hours of course credit for graduation (as contrasted with the usual 89 semester hours) and earn at least 21 of these semester hour credits in the area of entrepreneurial law. A student who satisfies all of the course requirements for the Certificate shall be awarded the certificate if the student earned at least a 72 in each course designated by the student as satisfying the Certificate requirements. **Consequently, the Certificate requires completion of the normal requirements for the *Juris Doctor* degree, augmented by an additional six semester hours of credit (for a total of 95 hours of credit).**
