- Overview of legal research certificate class and workshops. Because courses weren't offered for credit they could not use Blackboard. Libguides page for class has:
 - "slideshare" widget hosts powerpoint slides, tracks views.
 - Chart program called "Giffy." great for visual learners.
 - o "Snagit" allows one to create demonstrational visualization with notation.
 - Survey software used to collect feedback on course.
- This past year, DU legal research instructors used coursesites.com instead of libguides to create course pages. Made two pages: one for day students and one for evening.
 - CMS and editor are very intuitive, similar to blackboard paradigm.
 - Use captivate for video and slide tutorials because editing is easier.
 - o Great class guizzes hosted on the coursesites tool.
 - Tool offered extra tracking and workflow constraints for evening student to make sure that they do the work.
- Panopto: Online course capture software. Different windows for classroom video, slideshow presentation, and audience comments.
