

Undergraduate Development Award Application

Up to \$400 is available to undergraduates in the College of Music for expenses associated with presenting at professional conferences, performing at off-campus competitions, festivals, or master classes, and participating in selective summer festival/educational programs (NOT including the Aspen Music Festival, which has a separate scholarship fund). To be eligible for an undergraduate development award, students must be program participants and not simply attending the event. Students are encouraged to submit proposals in advance of the event.

- Faculty recommendation

The faculty recommendation should be confidential – placed in an envelope that is sealed and signed across the back seal by the faculty member. Applications without a faculty recommendation will not be accepted.
