Students may incur late charges if their tuition bill is not paid by the due date (see <u>colorado.edu/bursar</u>). Please be aware of these dates when sending your scholarship payment and allow sufficient time for processing.

We deposit co-payable scholarship checks without the student's signature.

Scholarships of more than \$2,500 are equally divided between fall and spring semesters unless otherwise instructed. Scholarships of \$2,500 or less are credited in full to the current semester. We will not release funds for students enrolled in fewer than 3 credit hours (undergraduate), 1 credit hour (graduate) or students who are not meeting the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy (see <u>colorado.edu/financialaid/policies</u>) without donor approval.

Scholarship Services will contact the donor in the event a recipient fails to enroll half time or meet the specified minimum enrollment, or is otherwise ineligible to receive the scholarship payment based on the scholarship requirements. If the student withdraws from the university before the third Friday of the current term, the scholarship will be canceled, and a refund will be processed. The donor may request a refund if the student withdraws after the third Friday of the term.
