If your permit was stolen from a campus location, contact the University of Colorado Police Department at 303-492-6666 at any time. Completion of a theft report is required for police investigative follow-up regarding the theft of your permit. Your report may be made at our Customer Service window at 1050 Regent Drive, or CU police can respond to your campus residence or workplace.

2. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION: Vehicles parked on campus displaying parking permits that have been reported lost or stolen are subject to tow and impound. The operator/owner of any vehicle displaying such a permit will be liable for all applicable fines and penalties including tow and impound fees. Criminal charges may be filed against persons in possession of parking permits that have been reported stolen.

3. SURRENDER OF LOST/STOLEN PERMITS REQUIRED: Permits that have been reported lost or stolen are not valid for use as parking authorizations. Recovered lost or stolen permits must be returned to Parking and Transportation Services. Vehicles found displaying lost or stolen permits will be issued a citation and will be subject to tow and impound at the owner's expense.
