

## 2008 CU-Boulder College Alcohol Study

### Q1 Informed Consent

Please read the following material that explains this research study. If you choose to participate by selecting the "I consent to participating in this study" answer below, this will indicate that you have been informed about the study and that you want to participate. We want you to understand what you are being asked to do and what risks and benefits - if any - are associated with the study. This should help you decide whether or not you want to participate.

You are being asked to take part in a research project conducted by Richard Jessor, PhD, Director, Health and Society Program, Institute of Behavioral Science, UCB 483, Boulder, CO 80309-0483 and Jane Curtis, MA Director, Alcohol and Other Drugs Program, UCB 159, Boulder, CO 80309. **Project Description:** This research survey is about alcohol use among college students. You are being asked to participate in this study as you were chosen at random from the undergraduates at CU Boulder. It is entirely your choice whether or not to participate in this study.

**Procedures:** If you agree to take part in this study, you will be asked to answer 80 questions about your attitudes regarding alcohol use. Participating should take approximately an hour of your time, and you will be able to participate from a computer that is convenient to you.

**Risks and Discomforts:** The potential risks associated with this experiment are minimal. You will be asked to provide your personal opinions about some potentially sensitive social issues regarding alcohol use and your behaviors. Some people may be slightly uncomfortable doing this. We are only interested in your opinions, so remember that there is no right or wrong answers and that your responses will be anonymous.

**Benefits:** There are no direct benefits for participating in this study. However, there is a larger benefit to society and scientific research with your participation.

**Source of Funding:** Funding for this study is being provided by The University of Colorado Boulder, Division of Student Affairs, Alcohol and Other Drugs Program Office.

**Cost to Participant:** There are no costs to you for participation in this study.

**Subject Payment:** All students who complete the survey will be eligible to win one of five \$500 cash prizes, provided by the Alcohol and Other Drugs Program Office. The students who complete the survey will have their contact information entered into a drawing for the awards to be given out on the last day of classes. You will receive information on how to pick up your payments via email. If you choose to withdraw before the conclusion of this study you will not receive any payment or be included in the drawing.

**If You Are Injured or Harmed:** If you feel that you may have been harmed while participating in this study, you should inform Richard Jessor, PhD immediately. The cost for any treatment will be billed to you or your medical or hospital insurance. The University of Colorado at Boulder has no funds set aside for the payment of health care expenses for this study. If you should find the need to make an injury claim, Colorado State Law allows for claims to be made within 180 days of the discovery of injury (Article 24-10-109).

**Study Withdrawal:** You have the right to stop participating at any time. To do this, just close your browser's window to exit the survey. If you do this, you will discontinue the survey, and your previous responses will not be recorded. You have the right to refuse to answer any question(s) for any reason.

**Confidentiality:** We will make every effort to maintain the privacy of your data. Your responses will be coded with an anonymous participant number and then disconnected from your name by the researcher. Your individual privacy will be maintained in all published and written data resulting from this study. Other than the researchers, only regulatory agencies such as the Office of Human Research Protections and the University of Colorado Human Research may see your individual data (without your name) as part of routine audits.
