

PHYS 1140 emailed score reports

During the last few weeks of the course, you will receive regular email reports of your scores on homework assignments, in-class clicker questions, pre-lab questions, and laboratory reports. We send these reports so you can compare the scores we have recorded against your own records. Please look at these email reports and send an email to Prof. Rogers at Charles.Rogers@colorado.edu if you see any discrepancies between the reported scores and what you believe to be correct scores.

Understanding the email

The email will have a message from Prof. Rogers with any new information about how recent the scores are. After this message, you will find a list of 'heading names' and numbers. The heading name tells you what the score is for; the number tells you the score. Here are the present heading names and what they mean:

H1	Homework assignment 1
H2	Homework assignment 2
H3	Homework assignment 3
H4	Homework assignment 4
H5	Homework assignment 5
Lab 1	Letter/number of the first lab, should be 'M1' for all students
PL1	Score on 1st pre-lab problems
L1	Score on 1st lab write up score
Lab 2	Second lab identification
PL2	Second pre-lab score
L2	Second lab write up score
Lab 3	etc. out to a maximum of Lab 6
PL3	etc. out to PL6
L3	etc. out to L6
Clicker	Total of your clicker score from class, with the lowest clicker score dropped
MaxClick	The maximum clicker score you could have received minus the clicker points you could have received on your worst clicker day.

The scores for homework and lab work should match the scores given to you by your TA.
