PLC alumnus (PLC '79, CU '83) Tim Pestotnik started a needs-based PLC scholarship in the spring of 2016. This scholarship is the only purely needs-based scholarship available exclusively to PLC students. Pestotnik scholarships are awarded to two students per semester with an award of \$2500. Students do not apply for the scholarship but must be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.00, and demonstrate a marked dedication to the program through course work, volunteerism, and community events.
