

The University of Colorado Police Department in Boulder is seeking motivated individuals to join the department as a Police Officer Trainee (called "Police-Intern").

Officers at UCPD are dedicated to providing high quality police services to enhance community safety, protect life & property, and to reduce crime and the fear of crime. Working closely with community members, UCPD officers provide 40,000 students, staff, and faculty with a full range of police responses.

Persons hired as Police Trainees are currently scheduled to be sponsored at a POST Law Enforcement Training Academy in January 2012.

Following graduation from the academy, trainees will be required to satisfactorily complete a department training program lasting up to 20-weeks to gain the skills and knowledge necessary to provide our community with excellent police services.

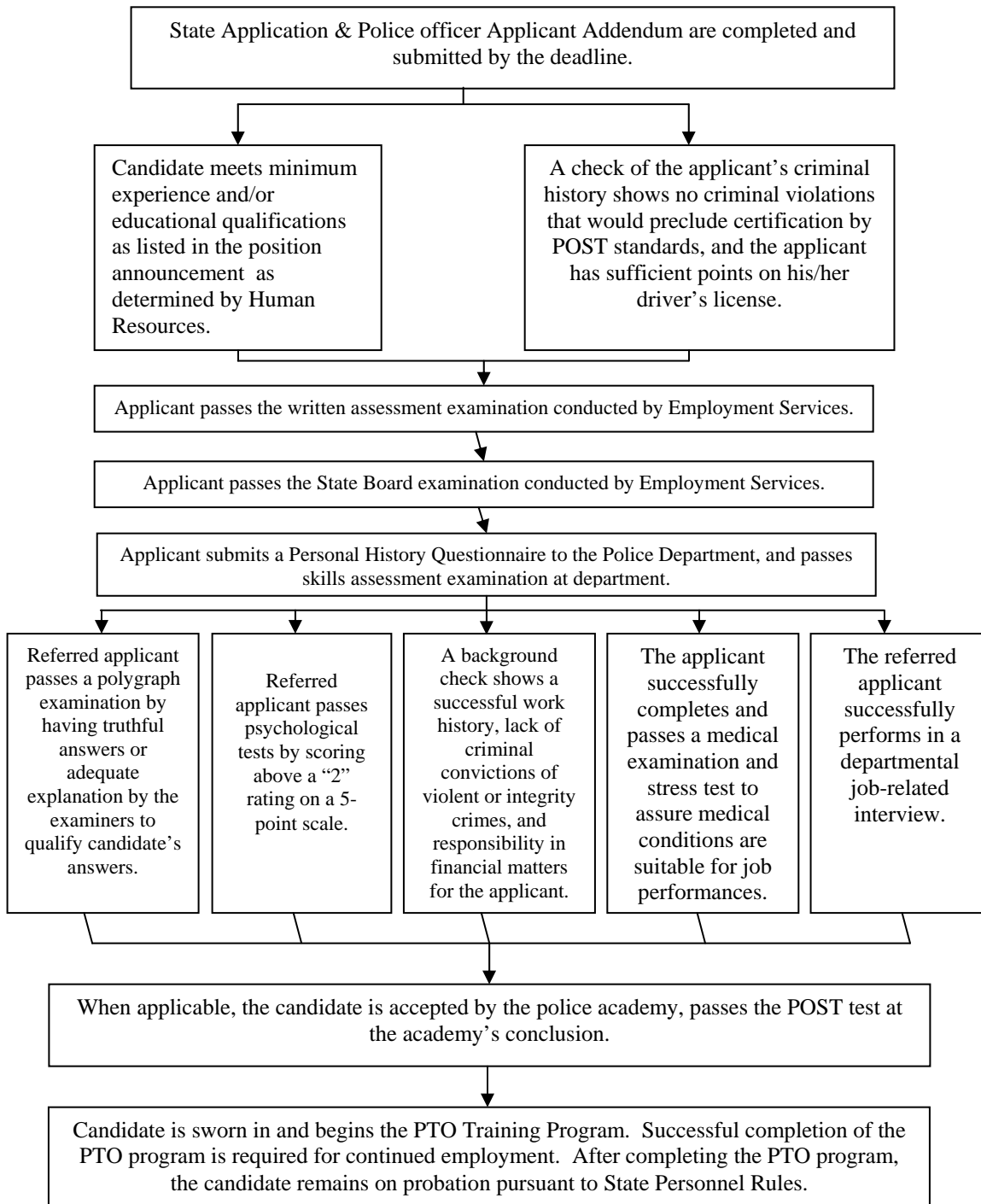

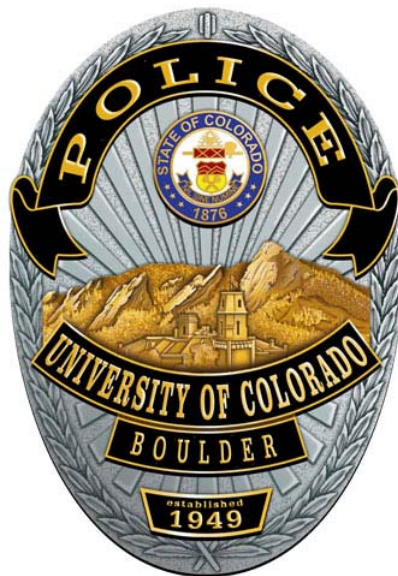


Approximate time table for **Police-Intern** hiring process:

- Preliminary Backgrounds: 8-29-11 to 9-9-11
- State Board Timeframe: 9-12-11 to 9-23-11
- Referrals from State Board: 9-28-11
- Department Assessment Boards 10-3-11 to 10-14-11
- Backgrounds, Poly, Psychs: 10-17-11 to 11-23-11
- Final Department Interview: 11-28-11 to 12-9-11
- Approximate Start date: January 3, 2012
- Approximate Academy Start: January 9, 2012
