The University of Colorado at Boulder Police Department is investigating a forcible fondling incident that reportedly occurred on August 23, 2009.

A victim came to UCPD on the afternoon of August 23, 2009, and conveyed that earlier that day, she had been grabbed by an unknown male. The victim stated she was unfamiliar with campus, and was looking for her dormitory at about 3:00 a.m. on August 23, 2009. An unknown male on a bicycle approached her while she was in the Kittredge vicinity, and offered directions. After arriving in the area of Farrand Field a few minutes later, the male on the bicycle approached the victim again and attempted to engage her in conversation.

The victim said she felt uncomfortable with the bicyclist, and told him she no longer needed his assistance since she knew where her residence hall was from that location. At this point, the male grabbed the victim's arms and pulled her toward him. The male then pulled up the victim's shirt and fondled her breasts.

The woman pushed the male away, and at this time two persons riding skateboards happened to come by the location. The victim enlisted the aid of the two skateboarders who walked her to her dorm.

The victim said the suspect is a white male, about 5-6 to 5-8 tall with shaggy brown hair. He was wearing shorts and a T-shirt. He may have had pierced ears with large earrings.
