The University of Colorado Police Department today (Feb. 23) obtained an arrest warrant for a suspect in the recent residence hall cases involving burglary, trespass and unlawful sexual contact.

The arrest warrant was signed by Judge James C. Klein of the Boulder District Court. The warrant lists the following charges, second degree burglary (10 Counts), unlawful sexual contact (2 Counts) and physical harassment (1 Count). Judge Klein set the bond amount on the warrant at \$2,500 and directed that the suspect have no contact with any victim or witnesses to these crimes.

The identity of the suspect, including his name, residence address, photograph and other identifying information is not being released at this time by the University of Colorado Police Department. While investigators have enough evidence to secure the arrest warrant the investigation is ongoing and additional victims and witnesses are still being contacted as a part of the investigative process. "The release of the suspect name and photograph could potentially taint those further investigative processes," said Joe Roy, chief of UCPD. "This information will be released to the public as soon as possible, when the investigative steps have been completed."

Roy added that the department would appreciate all assistance of the media in withholding the name and photograph of the suspect until this investigation has reached a stage where that information will not harm the investigative process.
