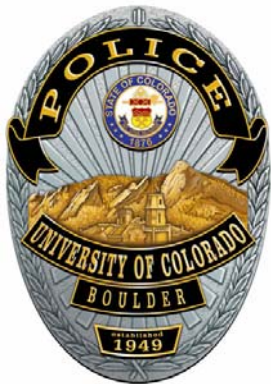

Grant funds used for warrant sweep

Officers with the Boulder and University of Colorado Police Departments recently completed a warrant sweep for outstanding alcohol-related warrants, specifically for the charge of unauthorized possession of alcohol by a minor. The sweep was conducted over the last two weeks and was funded by grant funds received last year and set to expire at the end of April.

During the sweep, officers arrested 41 people on 46 warrants. Four of those arrested had more than one warrant for their arrest and four others had warrants indicating no bond. Officers were searching for more than 130 people with warrants during the sweep.

This warrant sweep was funded by the Enforcing Underage Drinking Laws grant from the Colorado Department of Revenue, Liquor Enforcement Division through the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. The grant was received jointly by the Boulder Police Department and the University of Colorado to target underage drinking and the sale of alcohol to minors. The grant period was from March 23, 2006 through April 30, 2007.

People who are aware they have active warrants can contact the appropriate court for information about options for taking care of the warrant. People with active warrants are subject to arrest up until the warrant has been handled and are encouraged to turn themselves in to their local law enforcement agency, as any contact by police can result in their arrest.
