Criminal charges may be filed against persons in possession of parking permits that have been reported stolen.

3. SURRENDER OF LOST/STOLEN PERMITS REQUIRED: Permits that have been reported lost or stolen are not valid for use as parking authorizations. Recovered lost or stolen permits must be returned to Parking and Transportation Services. Vehicles found displaying lost or stolen permits will be issued a citation and will be subject to tow and impound at the owner's expense.
