

The Benefits of the StayConnected Program

Many of the benefits available through the StayConnected Program may require additional fees and approval. Please speak to the department that is offering the benefit through the StayConnected Program for more information about fees and approval.

The benefits include:

- purchase of Wardenburg student health insurance under certain conditions,
- purchase of the student Ecopass through the Buff OneCard Office, 303-492-0355
- access to the Recreation Center for a fee, 303-492-6880
- access to Career Services, 303-492-6541
- access to the Center for Multicultural Affairs, 303-492-5667
- Norlin library check out privileges, 303-492-8705
- access to online scholarship applications,
- retention of eligibility for renewable Financial Aid scholarships, (303) 492-5091
- work on campus for non-work study positions, 303-492-7349
 - International Students may **not** remain employed
- live in Family Housing, 303-492-6384, or Bear Creek, 303-735-2275, for one additional semester after last enrolled semester,
- and continued use of pre-purchased athletic tickets for the first semester of inactivity: 303-492-8337
 - Tickets cannot be purchased unless student was registered for at least four credit hours.

Please note that a copy of the StayConnected application given by the Office of the Registrar may be required as proof to access benefits with certain departments.
