The Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program offers up to \$4200 to faculty in support of semester-long undergraduate research seminars. Seminars should 1) focus primarily on the faculty member's research, creative, or scholarly work, or 2) focus generally on research in your academic area by introducing students to an array of work by practitioners from the discipline. Both approaches should have the goal of helping students understand what faculty do when they do research. Funds may be used for course release, overload pay, or expenses associated with the seminar.
