classical and modern expressions of Sufism including treatises on spirituality and ethics like *The Revelation of the Veiled* by Ali Hujwiri; commentaries on the Quran by Qushayri and Tustari; the timeless poetry of Rumi, Ibn al-Farid, and

Bulleh Shah; the music of Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan; and the mystical philosophy of Ibn Arabi and his followers. Learn how Sufism differs across cultural contexts, and how it compares to other great mystical traditions.
