You Must:

1. Meet with your McNeill Academic Coordinator for a beginning of semester check-in
2. Enroll in appropriate McNeill courses (math, writing, coseminars)
3. Attend two Power Hours scheduled on Oct. 9 and Oct. 30, 2009
4. Attend *Academic Intensive* (first semester)
5. Meet with your McNeill Academic Coordinator for a midterm check-in
6. Attend *Take 2* (second semester)

We Recommend:

1. Attend *Jump Start to CU* with your family before the fall semester begins
2. Attend at least three (3) *Power Hours* each semester
3. Work actively on the goals below
