We will meet at Denver International Airport on the day of departure. If you are local please attend the scheduled pre-trip meeting on Sunday May 17 at 5pm. Pack for the outdoors and be prepared for rain. We will be in Washington during the dry season, BUT it is the northwest, so you MUST be prepared. Pack items in an internal frame backpack and ONE duffel bag. Label and organize your belongings in clear plastic bags or stuff sacks to keep items organized and dry, just in case!

___ **\$100-\$125 spending money for several lunches and souvenirs**

CLOTHING/PERSONAL ITEMS

___ WEAR your hiking boots, **broken in** and water-proofed.

___ 1 pair of sneakers or sturdy walking shoes.

___ Teva's/Chaco's OR water shoes for water activities

___ Socks: 4 pair of lightweight wool or polypro; 3 pair of cotton

___ Rain jacket and rain pants REQUIRED

___ FLEECE jacket

___ Warm hat and light weight gloves

___ Long underwear top and bottom (light to medium weight)

___ 2 pair of quick dry long pants (zip-off legs highly recommended)

___ 3 pair of nylon or quick dry shorts

___ 2 long sleeve quick dry shirts (for sun)

___ 4 quick dry t-shirts

___ Underwear

___ 2 bandanas (important to have for a variety of uses)

___ Personal toilet kit: toothpaste, toothbrush, liquid soap, brush, lotion, bandaids

___ 1 of each: hand towel, thin bath towel, wash rag

___ Swimsuit

___ Insect repellent (Lotion only, please)

___ **SUN PROTECTION a MUST!** BRIMMED HAT, sunscreen/lip protection, sunglasses with strap

___ Prescriptions and allergy meds in the ORIGINAL labeled, bottle inside LABELED zip-loc bag

EQUIPMENT

___ Internal frame backpack (IF YOU HAVE ONE)

___ Small lightweight day pack

___ Light-weight polyester sleeping bag with stuff sack. Good to 20 degrees.

___ Foam pad or therma-rest

___ Unbreakable mug, silverware, medium-size bowl and plate in mesh LABELED bag.

___ 1 screw-top water bottle and one camel-back bladder

___ Small flashlight with extra batteries

___ Whistle on a cord

___ Miscellaneous plastic bags i.e. zip locs. large garbage bag for organizing or dirty clothing

___ Waterproof camera, small binoculars

Please do not bring iPods, electronics, knives, hair dryers, etc.
