II. Course Objectives

This course is designed to build a firm command of Portuguese grammar. Uses grammar as point of departure for development of oral skills. Beginning reading, listening comprehension, and writing skills are also stressed.

By the end of the course students should be able to communicate verbally at a beginning level in Portuguese. Students should have developed beginning listening comprehension, reading and writing skills. Students should also understand the basics of Portuguese grammar and be able to apply them in verbal and written communication.

III. Final Grade Evaluation:

- Active Class participation (10%)
- Exams (40 %)
- Oral Exams, (Written) Quizzes (15%)
- Activities Manual and other Written Assignments (15%)
- Final Exam (20%)
