Please note: Registration for seminars will not proceed until this form has been completed in its entirety.

- Students are required to choose a Faculty Advisor (normally this faculty member becomes the Chair of the PhD Supervisory Committee), with whom they will plan their program of study thereafter.
- Before the end of a student's third semester in the program, s/he must form a PhD Supervisory Committee (PhDSC). The PhDSC, which advises the student in all matters pertaining to the PhD program, will consist of five members of the graduate faculty and must be approved by the department Chair. The Chair of the PhDSC must be a member of the department's graduate faculty.
- Prior to taking the PhD Comprehensive Exams, all students must complete all courses for the degree. In addition, PhD students who did not take a teaching methodology seminar, a literary theory seminar, or a Hispanic Linguistics seminar as part of their MA program must do so as part of their PhD program. Students who did not take a minimum of three graduate credit hours in each of the seven subject areas as part of their MA program must make up coursework in these areas as part of the PhD program.
