- A \$1,000 general scholarship for 2017-2018 school year (annual, not renewable)

Criteria for Acceptance

- Honorably discharged from the military
- A cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher
- Accepted as a degree seeking undergraduate or graduate student at CU Boulder
- Completed at least one full-time semester at CU Boulder before Fall 2017
- FAFSA on file with the Office of Financial Aid
- Completed CU Boulder Veteran Services Scholarship Application

Packet

- Completed CU Boulder Veteran Services Scholarship Application
- A minimum 300 word essay explaining how your military experience combined with your higher education will benefit your community
- One Recommendation Form from an individual who can address the applicant's qualifications for the scholarship
- Proof of honorable discharge (Member-4 copy of your DD-214)
