### How to Host an Event in My Area

- Submit Event Interest Form and request grant funding if necessary. The form should include the event name, a description of the event and an estimate of how much the event might cost.
- Complete submission forms six to eight weeks before the event date. An Alumni Association team member will contact you within two business days to schedule a meeting to discuss event details.
- Consult with the volunteer manager to discuss marketing needs and/or funding requirements. The Alumni Association will send all marketing emails on your behalf.
  - Email requests: At least five to seven business days before the email send date.
  - Web requests: Allow five to seven business days to see the change reflected on the website.
- Respond within 24 hours to emails or phone calls from the volunteer engagement team.
- Download a sign-in sheet for your event.
- Submit a Post Event Report within seven days of the event.
