A World of Discovery

Connects | *Rice Noodles.* In Siem Reap, a local family opens their home to share secrets of making Cambodian rice noodles, part of their rich culinary tradition.

Balinese Village Life. Visit a local village to encounter daily life and interact with locals. Visit a school, plant rice or make floral offers while tasting Balinese snacks. Stroll through rice fields and savor an Indonesian lunch amid the paddies, and a foot massage!

Ubud Culture & Holy Temple. Venture to a holy water spring near Tampak Siring. Then, visit the Agung Rai Museum of Art in Abud to encounter the gamelan Indonesian music ensemble and try a few instruments! Stay at the museum or visit a colorful local market nearby to encounter local life and peruse.

Singapore. Explore the city on a panoramic tour. Pass Merlion Park and see the iconic, mythical lion/fish statue. In the Civic District, see the Padang, Cricket Club, Parliament House and more. Visit Singapore's oldest Chinese temple, Thian Hock Keng Temple.

Multicultural Singapore. Encounter this city-state's cultural diversity and eclectic history. Visit the Malay enclave of Kampong Glam, Chinatown's shophouses and Little India's exotic flower and spice markets.

Peranakan Heritage. Uncover Singapore's multicultural heritage at a Peranakan enclave. Visit a family business to learn about the history and preparation of traditional pineapple tarts, kueh chang, with a delicious tasting.

Gardens by the Bay. Delight in Singapore's landmark oasis of floral features and garden artistry. See the iconic Supertrees, made up of over 150,000 plants, plus bromeliads, orchids, ferns and climbers. Spend time Cloud Forest and the Flower Dome, the largest glass greenhouse in the world.

Chao Phraya River Cruise. See Bangkok's landmarks during a scenic dinner cruise on the Chao Phraya River aboard a converted rice barge. Delight in the sparkling sites and enjoy drinks and an authentic Thai dinner.

Bangkok. Discover daily river life as you cruise the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi canals. Disembark to visit the Grand Palace and Emerald Buddha Temple, followed by a tuk-tuk ride to see the Reclining Buddha. Then, savor a fusion of old and new recipes during lunch at the famed Blue Elephant.

Ayutthaya. Visit the Bang Pa-In Palace, a summer residence for the kings of Thailand. Continue to ancient Ayutthaya, now home to brick ruins, lion statues, seated Buddha figures and other amazing artifacts.

Siem Reap. Discover this provincial capital during a tuk-tuk tour, and visit an art and dance center to see artisan demonstrations.

Angkor Wat. Marvel at bas-relief murals and more at this 12th-century crown jewel of the park and the world's largest temple. *(Active)*

Angkor's Temples. Explore Angkor Thom, home to the imposing Bayon temple. Marvel at Ta Prohm, swathed by massive tree roots, and admire exquisite Apsara carvings at Thommanon, a notable example of grand Khmer temple architecture. *(Active)*

Cultural Performances. Admire traditional performing artists during a Cambodian circus and Khmer classical dance and music.
