Days 1 & 2 | In Transit

Depart gateway city for Auckland, New Zealand. Cross the international date line.

Day 3 | Auckland, New Zealand

Upon arrival, transfer**Э** to the Grand Mercure Auckland. Join your Travel Director later for a short stroll in the neighborhood around the hotel.

Enrichment: The Legend of Tamaki

Makaurau. New Zealand's first inhabitants were the Maori, whose ancestors traveled by canoe from Polynesian islands in A.D. 1300 and called the land they discovered, Aotearoa, or "Land of the Long White Cloud." Hear the Maori legend of Auckland's origins as well as other folklore. Tonight, at the hotel, get to know your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 4 | Auckland

Discovery: *City of Sails.* On a scenic tour, see the city's highlights. Ride over the Auckland Harbour Bridge and take in fantastic skyline views from the North Shore. Visit the lively Viaduct Harbour, bustling Queen Street and Auckland Domain park. At the Auckland War Memorial Museum, view one

of the world's premier collections of Maori *taonga*, or treasures, and witness a traditional *haka*, the fierce and defiant war dance of Maori men. Later, in Parnell, Auckland's oldest suburb, meander along charming streets filled with restaurants, boutiques and specialty shops.

Free Time: Make your own plans in Auckland.

Day 5 | Auckland | Queenstown

This morning, fly from the city's domestic airport to Queenstown on the South Island.

Enrichment: Extreme Sports in New

Zealand. Known as the "Adventure Capital of the World," Queenstown attracts thrill-seekers drawn to its exhilarating outdoor activities, including

white-water rafting, bungee jumping, jet boating and sky diving. Learn more about these extreme sports at a bungee site near Queenstown. Check in to the Crowne Plaza Queenstown.

Day 6 | Queenstown

Discovery: *Safari of the Scenes.* Director Peter Jackson, a native New Zealander, chose the ethereal natural beauty of his homeland to represent Tolkien's Middle-earth in his "Lord of the Rings" movies. On an exciting guided drive in an SUV, discover the spectacular locations around Queenstown that starred in the films. Admire the marvelous panorama of Wakatipu Basin, then venture down a historic gold mining road and try panning for gold.

Free Time: The afternoon is at leisure. For sweeping vistas, climb aboard the Skyline Gondola for a gentle ride up Bob's Peak.

Day 7 | Queenstown

Discovery: *Doubtful Sound Tour.* A truly memorable day awaits as you explore the jawdropping natural grandeur of Fiordland National Park. Cruise across the shimmering waters of Lake Manapouri framed by the Cathedral Mountain range. Then travel over the Wilmot Pass and see the Fiordland's verdant rain forest. Later, on a three-hour catamaran cruise, sail through the splendid stillness of Doubtful Sound, New Zealand's deepest fiord, as nature guides on board help you spot wildlife.

Day 8 | Queenstown

Free Time: Plan a fun day for yourself! Feeling adventurous? Your Travel Director can arrange optional activities on-site like a jet boat ride or a river safari. Looking for something more mellow? Cruise across Lake Wakatipu on a Queenstown icon, the *TSS Earnslaw*, a coal-fired steamship. Enjoy dinner by the lakeshore this evening.

Day 9 | Queenstown | Franz Josef Glacier

Discovery: *Scenic Drive to Franz Josef Glacier.* As you wend your way north, relax and watch the ever-changing scenery of impressive mountains, quiet valleys and the aquamarine waters of Lakes Dunstan, Hawea and Wanaka. Travel across the Haast Pass and see Thunder Creek Falls. Arrive in Franz Josef Glacier and check in to the hotel, where you'll dine tonight.

Day 10 | Franz Josef Glacier

Discovery: *Franz Josef Glacier.* View one of the world's fastest-moving glaciers on an invigorating, three-hour guided walk through the glacier valley. As you trek to this remarkable river of blue-tinted ice, your expert guide will share informative insights on its geological features and patterns.

After lunch, visit the West Coast Wildlife Center to see kiwi birds, found only in New Zealand, and learn about conservation efforts to protect the five endangered species of this beloved bird.





Day 11 | Greymouth | Christchurch

After breakfast, depart for Greymouth.

Discovery: *TranzAlpine Train Ride.* Settle in for this celebrated rail journey from

Greymouth to Christchurch as the train climbs through dense alpine forests and across the snowcapped Southern Alps. Glide next to the Waimakariri River and cross the golden Canterbury Plains.

Check in to the Crowne Plaza Christchurch.

Day 12 | Christchurch

Discovery: *Christchurch.* Get acquainted with this vibrant city, the largest on the South Island, on a panoramic tour. Make your way through the city center set on the banks of the Avon River and see Cathedral Square and other highlights. After some free time in the Botanic Gardens, head further afield to admire the seaside suburbs of Sumner and Redcliffs.

Enrichment: Canterbury Past, Present

& Future. Christchurch is the capital of Canterbury, an important agricultural and business region tucked between the Southern Alps and the eastern



coast. An expert at the Canterbury Museum shares historical insights.

Free Time: Explore on your own this afternoon.

Day 13 | Kaikoura | Blenheim

Check out of the hotel and journey north along the picturesque coast toward Blenheim.

Discovery: *Kaikoura.* On your route, visit this town famous for the abundance of marine mammals that live in the waters off its peninsula. Giant sperm whales are year-round residents as well as fur seals and dusky dolphins. Orcas, the largest of the dolphin family, are seen here, along with migrating species of whales including the Humpback, Pilot and Blue. It's also home to New Zealand's largest concentration of seabirds. Marvel at these amazing creatures at close range on a whale-watching cruise.

After your cruise, travel into the heart of the idyllic Marlborough wine region and arrive at the Marlborough Riverside Hotel in Blenheim.

Day 14 | Blenheim

Discovery: *Marlborough Wines.* New Zealand's largest winegrowing region first grabbed the world's attention in the 1980s with its aromatic Sauvignon Blanc. Blessed with a remarkably sunny, dry and cool climate, Marlborough's wine producers have since expanded into a wide range of delicious styles. Sample the fine creations of Cloudy Bay Winery, one of the first five wineries in the region, during a private tour and tasting.

AHI Connects: Rock Ferry Winery.

Enjoy a relaxing, casual lunch and tasting at this family-owned organic winery.

Free Time: Strike off on your own to explore more of Blenheim this afternoon.

Day 15 | Blenheim

Free Time: Create your own agenda on your final day! Book a tour to other wineries, take a cruise through the majestic Marlborough Sounds





or check out the top-notch eateries and independent boutiques in town. History buffs will love the vintage war planes and artifacts at the fascinating Omaka Aviation Heritage Centre. Your Travel Director can offer recommendations and help with reservations.
