In the <u>first month</u> of the semester in which you are ready to graduate with an MS degree (ie, you have 30.0 course credits and you've passed a prelim already):

Please fill out and submit a Graduate Program Change/ Addition Form to <a href="mailto:amgradco@colorado.edu">amgradco@colorado.edu</a> , <a href="mailto:found here">found here</a> . (Search "CU Boulder" > "Academic Resources" > "Forms" > "Graduate Program Change/ Addition Form")
After doing the above, please wait 5 business days* and then:
Apply to graduate with your MS in your Buff portal
Please fill out and submit an online Candidacy Application Form, found here.  (Search "CU Boulder" > "Academic Resources" > "Forms" > "Candidacy App for Adv Degree")
Please fill out and submit a Master's Examination Form found here. (Search "CU Boulder" > "Academic Resources" > "Forms" > "Master's Examination Form") For this form, you'll need to add the names of your 2 prelim exam proctors, and the third name should be the current Grad Chair as your three "committee members." If you don't remember your proctors' names, please email amgradco@colorado.edu for a list!

\*Or just wait for your GPA to send you notice that your Program Addition has been approved by the Registrar and that an MS degree has been added to your dock. You can't apply to graduate with an MS, if you don't have an MS on your dock.
